### **Terms and Conditions**

By submitting your artworks, you agree to comply with the Terms and Conditions inclusive of all information provided.

#### **Key Dates:**

- Applications close – **7<sup>th</sup> January, 2022**
- Delivery date of artworks – by **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022, 5pm.**
- Official opening – **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2022, 6pm.**
- Collection date for artworks – **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2022**
- Exhibition Dates – **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2022**

#### **Entry Terms and Conditions:**

- Entries will use the theme of the Cape Jaffa Lighthouse, aiming to capture the essence of this unique lighthouse.
- Each art work must be the Artist's uncopied, **original** work.
- 2-D artworks to be presented ready for hanging in a professionally framed or presented manner, preferably with flat D-rings and wire. 3-D artwork to provide information as to whether or not a plinth is needed.
- A label with the artist's name, title of work, medium and price must be attached clearly on the back of each work submitted.
- Each artwork will be for sale at the price nominated by the artist on the ENTRY FORM.
- A commission of 30% will be charged by the exhibition venue, *small space studio*, on exhibited artworks that are sold.
- The **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize** reserves the right to refuse to accept or display any exhibit that does not comply with the terms or conditions or is considered unsuitable, without being required to give a reason.
- The maximum area for each artwork is 1 metre squared, excluding frame or mount.
- Art works will only be accepted if they are submitted by the closing date, **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> Jan, 5pm.** *LATE entries will NOT be accepted or exhibited.*
- Artists are responsible for delivery and collection of work. Artworks must be delivered in person or consigned to *small space studio*, 18 Agnes Street, Kingston se, SA 5275, by **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> Jan, 5pm.**

- All art works must remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition.
- At the conclusion of the exhibition, all art works must be collected from the exhibition venue at the designated collection time, **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2022**. Artists who require their art work to be returned via mail or courier must provide labelled return packaging, instructions and payment for the return of art work. *All freight and delivery charges incurred are the responsibility of the artist.*
- Whilst all reasonable care will be taken by the Organisers all entries are submitted at the total risk of the artist. Insurance in transit, in storage and while on display is the artist's responsibility. The exhibition venue, *small space studio* and the Organisers of the event, are not responsible for loss or damage.
- The **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize** reserves the right to photograph works exhibited in the **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize** for the purpose of documentation and promotion. The **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize** will be allowed to photograph, video and/or publish the works for the purposes of producing a catalogue or otherwise promoting the event.
- Winners will be announced at the Opening of the **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize**. The Opening will take place at *small space studio*, 18 Agnes St., Kingston SE, on **Thursday 13th January, 2022, 6pm**. The results, as determined by the judges are final and no discussion will be entered into.

The **LIGHTHOUSE Art Prize** is a non-acquisitive prize. Prize winners will be chosen from those works exhibited in the exhibition in January, 2022.

- Award 3D - \$1,000.00
- Award Photography - \$1,000.00
- Peoples' Choice Award - \$250.00
